

## SCISSA SECONDARY – CRICKET – BY LAWS Updated 18th October 2007

Laws as per The Laws of Cricket (2000 Code 2nd edition – 2003)

The name "Twenty20" implies that each team in a Twenty 20 cricket match will have a maximum of 20 overs

A bowler can bowl a maximum of four overs.

Bowling team gets same number of overs as batting team the week before.

12 overs must be bowled each innings otherwise it will be a draw.

Game should be played on a recognised cricket ground that has a turf or mat wicket

Markers may be used for the boundary rope

Dismissals as per the normal rules of cricket see The Laws of Cricket (2000 Code 2nd edition – 2003)
